

Reporting Safeguarding Concerns, Allegations or Incidents.

If there is an immediate danger, ring 999

If you have a safeguarding concern or are aware of a safeguarding incident you should report it. If you're not sure, don't do nothing, it is always best to follow this procedure. If you have reported on a local basis and the situation concerns a TOM member, you should still report it through TOM.

Make a written record of your concerns, using the form below and give to the TOM Designated Safeguarding Person (DSP)



The TOM DSP will report to the Diocesan Safeguarding Advisor linked to TOM, within 24 hours. They will discuss next steps to take. Our current DSA is Sarah Price in Coventry Diocese.
